Bramble Trustees of Bethel Church and their successors in Office a parcel of Land lying, being and situate in the District and State aforesaid, on the West side of Siders Road on the side of the Church lot at Bethel, beginning at a stone corner thence S 40 N 5/2 E to stake at the end of R. Bramble lane thence S 42 E 6 Chs to Stake, N 64 E 5 Chs to the first thence N 6 E to a pine 5 Chs 6 2 lines, containing Three acres more or less, with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same or in anywise belonging, to have and to hold all and singular the premises hereunto mentioned unto the said Trustees and their successors in Office for ever to be held in trust for the use of Bethel Church. And I do hereby bind myself to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Trustees and their successors in Office, against myself my heirs and assigns and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. L. Permitt his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said B. L. Permitt his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
