To Assignment

This Indenture made this 28th

day of May 1885, between William H. Goodlett Jr. and Lathrop W. Osborne, partners doing business under the name of W. H. Goodlett & Co. of the first part and John R. Bellinger of the second part witnesseth, that whereas the said parties of the first part are indebted unto divers persons, and being unable to pay the whole of the debts or sums of money owed by them, have proposed and agreed to assign all of their estate and effects unto the said party of the second part, in trust for the benefit of the Creditors of said parties of the first part in the manner hereinafter mentioned: Now this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance and performance of said proposed and agreement, and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to the said parties of the first part, paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said William H. Goodlett Jr. and Lathrop W. Osborne, Partners as aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, released, assigned, transferred and delivered, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, assign, transfer and deliver unto the said John R. Bellinger, all and singular the Stock in trade, goods, wares and Merchandise, stocks and Store fixtures, sums and sums of money, notes, accounts and other things due and owing to the said William H. Goodlett Jr. and Lathrop W. Osborne, jointly or individually, as partners or otherwise; and also all the real, personal or mixed estate of the said William H. Goodlett Jr. and Lathrop W. Osborne or either of them, except such property as is by law exempt from sale for the payment of debts, to have and to hold all and singular the said property unto the said John R. Bellinger, his heirs, Executors, Administrators

and assigns forever, in trust nevertheless to sell and dispose of the said Stock of goods, wares and Merchandise, Store fixtures &c. for Cash as speedily as convenient, to collect said Notes, accounts and other evidences of debt as quickly as may be, and to sell and dispose of the real estate of necessity for Cash, and out of the proceeds of such sales and collections to pay, first, the Cost of executing this assignment including Commissions and a fee of twenty five dollars to be paid to Bylinger & Helyde, Second, to pay all the Creditors of said W. H. Goodlett & Co. who will accept a pro rata share of their claims and a under this assignment and release the assignors from further liability upon said claims, if the proceeds of the assigned property shall be sufficient to pay all creditors in full, said acceptance and agreement to release as aforesaid to be made within ninety days after the date hereof, Third, to pay all other Creditors of said W. H. Goodlett & Co. or of either William H. Goodlett Jr. or Lathrop W. Osborne, and finally, if, after paying all of said claims and all expenses, any balance should remain, or any property be still unsold, to transfer, convey, assign and pay over the same to the said William H. Goodlett Jr. and Lathrop W. Osborne or such person as they may appoint, and the said John R. Bellinger, for himself, his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns, doth hereby accept the said deed of Assignment and consent to the trusts hereby created, his witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this twenty fifth day of May A.D. 1885.
