 day of August A.D. 1885. Witness, that James
 Massey of Greenville County, do hereby lease demise
 and let unto James Huff and P. Huff of Greenville
 County, a certain parcel of Land in Greenville County
 and State of South Carolina, with all the buildings
 thereon standing and the appurtenances to the
 same belonging with the rights and tenures only

for building purposes and fire wood, the said lands
 lie west of Grove Creek and south of a Branch running
 into Grove Creek and known as part of the John son
 Lands. To hold for the term of three years from the 25th
 day of Dec 1885, yielding and paying therefor the rent
 of One hundred & fifty dollars per year, and said leasee
 and premises to pay the said rent annually on the 25th
 day of November in each year, and to quit and de-
 liver up the premises to the lessor or his Attorney, peace-
 ably and quietly at the end of the term in as good or
 der and condition reasonable use and wearing there-
 of, fire and other unavoidable Casualties Excepted
 as the same now are or may be but in by the said
 lessor, and to pay the rent as above stated, and not to
 make or suffer any waste thereof, nor lease, nor under-
 let nor permit any other person or persons to occupy
 or improve the same, or make or suffer to be made
 any alteration therein, but the approbation of the
 lessor thereto in writing, having been first obtained,
 and that the lessor may enter to view and make
 improvements and Expel the Lessee, if he fail to pay
 the rent as aforesaid, or make or suffer any waste
