Georges land on West, by A. Kings land on North, by Stephen S. Georges on the East by Jas M. Daniel on the South, containing one hundred acres more or less, having such shape, line and distances as is laid down in the original papers now in possession of the said Zadoc Thaxton, together with all and singular the rights and advantages belonging to the said premises to have and to hold the said tract of land hereby granted with its appurtenances unto the said Zadoc Thaxton jointly to them and their heirs forever, and we the said Jas.
