Complaint for Relief &c in the Court of Common Pleas for the County
 of Greenville and State aforesaid against Thomas M. Cox Thomas C. Green
 William B. Binn and others Defendants wherein among other things
 it was alleged that one John Westfield deceased on the 28th
 of ¹⁸⁷³ A.D. 1873 sold and conveyed to the Plaintiff W. Synner and
 T. M. Cox and J. C. Gower the Defendants and to one J. Binn deceased
 now deceased and undivided fourth (1/4) of the interest in and to cer-
 tain real estate and around the City of Greenville in the County
 and State aforesaid and more particularly described in the deed of
 conveyance of that date and on the 30th day of September A.D.
 1873 the said John Westfield agreed to sell to the firm of Cox Binn
 & Co. (which was composed of himself and other parties to aforesaid) of
 certain other lots or parcels of land in and near the City of Greenv-
 ills and County and State aforesaid and more particularly described
 in said agreement and that the said parties who were interested
 in the lands aforesaid in order to facilitate the sale and trans-
 fer of lands had agreed to and among themselves to convey
 all of the said land in trust to two of their number to sell and
 divide the proceeds among the parties according to their respec-
 tive interests and prayed among other things that there might
 be inquired into and if found advisable carry out
 the said agreement in reference to a Trust Deed that a sui-
 table Trust Deed be reported together with some suitable
 person or persons to act as trustee or trustees and whom upon
 the said cause being heard on the 17th day of June A.D. 1874
 it was referred to a Special Referee to report on the various
 matters embraced in the pleadings in said cause and upon
 the report of said Special Referee conveying the same
 among the various Recommendations therein more fully set
 forth it was on the 27th day of August A.D. 1874 among
 other things ordered that W. Synner and J. C. Gower
 be appointed trustee to whom William M. Daniel Clerk of
 the said Court should convey the said lands to have and
 to hold the same to for and upon the purposes uses and
 trusts as set forth and declared in the Deeds reported by
 the said Referee and whom the said William M. Daniel
 Clerk as aforesaid did convey the said lands mentioned in the
 pleadings to the said Trustees. Now therefore know all
 men by these presents that we J. C. Gower and W.
 Synner Trustees as aforesaid by virtue of the power
 conferred upon us in and by the order and Trust De-
 ed aforesaid upon the within request of the said
