 bargained sold released assigned transferred and delivered and  
 do hereby grant bargain sell release assign transfer and  
 deliver unto the said Gower & Reilly all of the Capital  
 stock of the Street Railway Company of Greenville  
 S. C. and all and singular the road bed tracts Chaparral  
 in dross and other Material of every nature and  
 appurtenances belonging and appertaining to the

Railway also all of the Passenger Cars Freight Cars platform  
 cars and other rolling stock of said Street Railway with the  
 harness and fixtures belonging to the same also the old Bag-  
 gage Wagon and the Omnibus with the harness for the same  
 also all of the Franchises Powers Rights and Privileges apper-  
 taining and belonging to the said Street Railway Company  
 of Greenville S. C. whether by Acts of the Legislature of this  
 State or otherwise the deed of bargain and sale being enter-  
 ded to cover everything belonging to or connected with the said  
 Street Railway or Street Railway Company save and except only  
 the live stock and wagons (except the old Baggage wagon) and  
 harness for said wagons. To have and to hold all and singular

 assigns against ourselves our heirs Executors and Admin-  
 istrators and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof. And we do further con-  
 mant and agree to and with the said Gower & Reilly as a part  
 of this contract of bargain and sale that we will not engage  
 either as a firm individually or otherwise in the business  
 of hauling either Passengers Freight or Baggage in or near  
 the City of Greenville S. C. except that we reserve the right  
 to do the draying of our own house of the Hilbreath Opera  
 House for short periods of Hilbreath & Plamie of Lipscomb  
 & Russell out of the Clothing houses in the City and as  
 to these the said Gower & Reilly agree not to interfere
