bargained, sold and released and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
William S. Moore all that parcel or tract of land be-  
ing and lying in Greenville County, a State aforesaid,  
situated in Fairview township and containing  
One hundred and sixteen acres, more or less being  
a part of the land deeded by John Baldwin to William  
S. Daens being a part of the same tract deeded by  
Robert McKay to Kendred Story, bounded on the  
West by Reedy River, on the South by lands of W. S. Moore,  
on the East lands of Lidy Cox and W. S. Moore, on the North  
by W. S. Moore's land and S. Mansing Cox. Together  
with all and singular the Rights, Members, Heredit-  
aments, and appurtenances to the said Premises  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertain-  
ing. To have and to hold, all and singular the  
said premises before mentioned unto the said  
William S. Moore his Heirs and Assigns forever.  
And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Exe-  
cutors and Administrators, to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises un-  
to the said William S. Moore his Heirs and Assigns
