come I, E. J. Douthitt, Master in and for the County of  
said, send Greeting: Whereas, Robert A. Dickson as  
Executor of the last will and testament of Fannie  
E. Dickson, deceased, on or about the 14th day of Sep-

eighty five exhibited his complaint in the Court of
