to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these
presents by J. J. Owens (the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged) have granted, bargained sold and re-
leased and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and release unto the said J. J. Owens all
of two certain pieces, parcels, tracts and lots of
land, situate, lying and being, Lot No. 14 in Greenville
County, Lot No. 22 in Laurens County, marked Lot No.
14 and Lot No. 22 in J. K. Dickson's survey of 23rd Janu-
ary 1886. Lot No. 22 is described as follows, Beginning
at a corner stone 3 x n. or Pine stump at Cox's Land, on
the Greenville and Laurens Road running thence N.
18 1/2 E. 45.50, line of Ed. Cox's Land, to Red Oak 3 x 0. S. S. S.
Knight's Land, thence N 70 1/2 W 11.75, line of S. S. S. Knight's
Land, to stone 3 x n. corner of Lot No. 21, thence S. 20 1/2 W 34.14,
line of Lot No. 21, to stone 3 x n. on the Greenville and Laurens
Road, thence with said Road to beginning corner;
Bounded by lands of Ed. Cox and S. S. S. Knight and
Lots Nos. 21 and 23; Containing fifty two and one half
