 do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

said Henry Moreley, all that certain piece, parcel and
 lot of land, situate, lying and being in said County
 and State, on the North side of Washington Street,
 West of Air Line Depot, containing by estimation one
 acre, one rood and ten poles, and designated as No.
 12 on Jas. K. Dickson's plat, and having the following
 lines, metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a
