State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by The Greenville and Laurens Rail Road Co. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville and Laurens Rail Road Co. its assigns and successors, all that lot or parcel of land containing one quarter of an acre more or less, situate in the Eastern part of the City of Greenville, Beginning at a stake 34 m. on Court Street, thence N. 72 1/2 W. 87 3/4 links to a stake 34 m. on said street, thence S. 18 1/2 W. 304 chs. to a stake 34 m., thence S. 75 1/2 E. 78 3/4 links to a stake 34 m., thence N. 18 1/2 E. 304 chs. to the beginning stake 34 on said Court Street. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville and Laurens Rail Road Company its assigns and successors forever. And I do hereby certify that
