McIntosh a one half interest in my entire stock of goods, consisting of Drugs, Medicines, Chemicals and all other articles whatsoever now in store house, corner Main and Washington Streets in the City of Greenville, State aforesaid. To Have and to Hold the said above described property unto the said John B. S. McIntosh his heirs, Executors, Administrators, and assigns; to his and their only proper use and behoof forever. And I the said Frank A. Walter do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and Administrators, the said bargained premises, unto the said John B. S. McIntosh his Executor, Administrators and assigns, from and against all persons, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these Presents. J. M. McGee in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by Henry White in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do Grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry White all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and the City of Greenville, the same being the lot deeded to me by Emma E. Hardin on the first day of Dec. 1883, commencing at a stake at the N.W. corner of the Allen Thompson lot and running with Echols Street N. 55th E 70 links to a stake, thence South 38 E. 2.86 to a stake on H. W. Winne line, thence S. 56 W. 69 links to a stake, thence N. 38 W. 2.86 to a stake containing four twentieths of an acre, more or less, and bounded by Echols Street, Mrs. Gossett, and others, and being the same lot of land conveyed by L. M. Gossett to John G. Greer of date 30th Dec. 1873 and recorded in Book D.P. page 242. and by John G. Greer to Kate L. Snider Jan. 1880. and by Kate L. Snider to Emma E. Hardin, March 24/83. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Henry White his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry White his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six and in the one hundred and tenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
