Johnson all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State aforesaid on waters of South Tyger River, and known as the Gosnell Mill tract, containing sixteen acres more or less, and more fully described in a deed executed by Jefferson Barton to John Gosnell on the 23rd day of December 1865. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises unto the said David M. Johnson, Marshall M. Johnson, and Jesse W. Johnson and their Heirs and Assigns forever.
