is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain, sell and release unto the said  
all that piece, parcel and tract of land, contain-  
ing five and one half acres, more or less, sit-  
uate, lying and being in the County and State  
aforesaid about four miles west of Greenville  
Court House on the north side of the White Horse  
road, adjoining lands of G. V. Willis, said Briggs  
and others and having the following metes  
and bounds, viz, Beginning at a stone 3 x on  
said road and running thence N. 35 E. 3.10 to a  
stone 2 x on, thence N. 49 W. 20.00 to a stone 3 x on on  
said White Horse road, thence with the road as  
a line 21.68 to the beginning, corner said described
