That I, W. J. Stone, of the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to me paid  
by James P. McKittrick of the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained,  
sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
James P. McKittrick all that certain portion  
parcel or tract of land situate lying and being  
in the aforesaid State and County on waters  
of Beaver dam creek and known as a part  
of the William Few tract and having the following  
metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:  
Beginning at a stone 3 x 20 m. on Common line  
and running thence N. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 25.50 to a pile of stones  
n. or the north bank of said Beaver dam Creek,  
thence N. 61 E. 12.60 to a stone 3 x, thence S. 28 E. 8.00 to
