That we, M. B. Goodlett and W. J. Goodlett in the State of aforesaid, County of Greenville in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Sixty seven Dollars, to us in hand paid ahead before the sealing of these presents, by E. E. Goodlett (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. E. Goodlett all that piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying in the County and State of aforesaid it being one third of a tract of land deeded to us by S. C. Dickson the 9<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1881, adjoining lands of S. Bishop, Wm Hill, R. Y. H. Shumate, and others and containing sixteen Acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining do have and to hold, all and singular the said premises, before mentioned unto the said E. E. Goodlett and her Heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said E. E. Goodlett her Heirs and assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness our Hands and Seals this 29<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six and in the one hundred and eleventh year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
