The State of South Carolina.

Whereas one William P. Turpin who died in about the year 1856 in the town of Greenville and State aforesaid left a last will and testament, which was duly admitted to probate in the then District of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the 26th day of March 1856, and, whereas, in said last will and testament, the said William P. Turpin devised his house and lot known at the time of the making of his said last will and testament, which is dated 4th May 1845, as number 416 Broome Street in the City and State of New York, and also his other house and lot known as number 186 Elm Street in the said City and State of New York and all his other freehold estate whatsoever and wheresoever the same might be, to certain trustees in trust for his wife, Louisa Turpin, who afterwards intermarried with one Thomas C. Markley, for and during the term of her natural life, and after her death
