J. S. Southern Sheriff of Green-  
ville County, and State aforesaid, send greeting  
whereas, by virtue of a writ of *Rein Facias*, issued  
out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the  
County of Greenville, dated the second day of  
November in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and sixty seven at the suit  
of J. W. Stokes to me directed, commanding  
me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and  
tenement of the Estate of Josiah Kilgore, dec'd, to  
levy the sum of Sixteen hundred and twenty  
nine <sup>69</sup> Dollars damages and costs, I have  
seized and taken of the land and tenement  
of the said Estate of Josiah Kilgore, deceased, all  
that certain piece, parcel and tract of land  
containing one hundred and seventy four

in the County of Greenville, in the State of
