Know all men by these presents, that we James William Huff and Franklin Lafayette Huff do hereby acknowledge and ratify and confirm the partition of land between ourselves and Augustus Huff, as reference to a deed from Pascal Isaac Huff as Trustee of James William Huff, Augustus Huff and Franklin Lafayette Huff, recorded in Book 53, page 205. It being the same tract of land conveyed on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 1866 by Chittenden Huff to Pascal D. Huff in trust for the said James William Huff, Augustus Huff and Franklin Lafayette Huff containing twelve hundred acres more or less. Recorded in Book 44, page 252 of the office of the Meane Conveyance for Greenville County, and in consideration money and of one dollar paid us by Augustus Huff, we and each of us do hereby renounce, release and forever relinquish unto the said Augustus Huff all of our right, title, interest and estate of in or to all and singular the premises described in a deed from Pascal Isaac Huff as Trustee to Augustus Huff to have and to hold the same to Augustus Huff, his heirs and assigns forever.
