E. P. Sudduth et al. Do and all Men by these Presents
that I, Alfred Taylor, in the State of South Carolina
for and in consideration of the sum of One
Dollar, to me in hand paid at and before the
making of these presents, by E. P. Sudduth and
E. D. Chismola, Deacons of the Church Springs
Baptist Church of Church Creek the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed,
bargained, sold and released and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Deacons or their successors
a certain lot or parcel of land for the sole
use and benefit of the Church Springs Baptist
Church only. If any attempt should be made
to use it for any other purpose than above
mentioned purpose: then the said parcel or lot
of land shall be returned to Alfred Taylor his
executors or authorities. I hereby reserve for
school purposes so much of said lot as is
covered by the school house and ten feet
around. The said Church's lot is supposed
to contain one and three eighths of an acre
more or less, beginning at an iron peg on
the main public road opposite the State
House now occupied by M. W. Goodlett run-
ning parallel with the orchard fence or
little west of North 270 feet or 90 yards to an
iron peg, thence about west 180 feet or 60 yards
to an iron peg on R. B. Gibsons line near a dog-
wood marked four and a half, thence S 37° W directly
through the school house and with R. B. Gibsons
and W. M. Shockleys line 300 feet or 100 yds. to
an iron peg near the edge of the public road
