

That I, J. P. Beattie of Greenville County in the State
 aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One
 hundred Dollars, to me paid by Starling Campbell
 of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have
 granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said Starling Campbell all that piece,
 parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
 in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
 about two and one half miles from Greenville
 Court House on the West side of the Anderson
 road, beginning at a stone 3x2 on the Anderson
 road, being the corner of a four acre lot pre-
 viously sold by me to said Campbell, thence along
 said Anderson road 2.26 to a stone 3x2, thence
 S. 38° W. 2.28 to a Red Oak stump 3x0, thence S. 48° E. 17.60
 to the beginning, as shown in a plot of the same
 made by J. N. Southern D.S. on 10th day of December
 1880, containing four acres, more or less.
 Together with all and singular the Rights, Members,
 Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said
 Premises belonging, or in anywise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and
 singular the said premises before mentioned
 unto the said Starling Campbell his Heirs and
 Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
 my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Starling Campbell his
 Heirs and Assigns, against one and my Heirs,
 and every other person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming, or to claim the same, or any part
