sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said George  
W. Sullivan Jr. all that piece, parcel or tract of  
land in the County of Greenville and State  
of South Carolina, on Reedy Fork Creek, waters of Reedy River  
and bounded as follows, Beginning on a  $\text{P. Oak}$   
 $3 \times$  stump with John Dagnall and Mrs. L. C. Sullivan  
line, thence N. 27° E. 25.00 chains to an ash  $8 \times$ , on west  
side of Reedy Fork Creek, thence down the meander  
of the said creek 28.30 chains to a Birch  $8 \times$
