Briggs, of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, in consideration of three hundred and fifty four dollars to me paid by the Greenville and Laurens Railroad Company, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said "The Greenville and Laurens Railroad Company" and its successors and assigns forever for railroad purposes a right of way fifty feet wide through my two lots of land, situate in said County and State, one between Pinkney St. and the Buncombe Road, and the other between Pinkney and Wash Street, said right of way to extend twenty five feet from the center of the track of said railroad, in opposite directions, and at right angles with the same, and containing one and one fourth acres. To have and to hold said right of way to the said Railroad Company and its successors and assigns forever, in fee simple, for railroad purposes.
