

R. F. Strand et al. vs. The State of South Carolina.
 To: Deed. Know all Men by these Presents, that
 Isabella J. Taylor, wife of Richard P. Strand, Mary A. Strand,
 Sabina D. Wright, Louisa A. Strand, Sanford L. Strand
 and Juliet A. McKinney of Greenville County in the
 State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum
 of Twenty five Dollars, to us in hand paid at and
 before the sealing of these presents, by Isabella J. Taylor
 of the same place (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged), have granted, bargained, sold and released
 and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and re-
 lease unto the said Isabella J. Taylor a certain piece
 parcel and tract of lands situate lying and being in
 the State and County of South Carolina on waters of Muskeget
 having the following lines metes and bounds, to wit:
 Beginning at a stone in the Buncombe road and run-
 ning thence S. 75 1/4 N. 38.88 to a stone, thence S. 13 E. 22.40
 to the mouth of small branch thence down the Run
 fork Branch to a stone in the forks of the said branch
 thence up the Buncombe road to the beginning. Con-
 taining Forty six and four tenths (46 4/10) acres, more
 or less. Bounded by lands of Sabina D. Wright, Louisa
 A. Strand and others, all except one acre which is
 reserved for a family Grave yard. Together with all
 and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in
 anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
