 J. M. Fisher Know all Men by these presents, that I Wm. Reid of Spartanburg Co. & State of S.C. and J. M. Fisher of Greenville County and State of S.C. have this day covenanted and agreed to enter into a contract of a lease of ten years of a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County and State of S.C. on the waters of Jamison's Mill Creek, waters of South Paolet River at the foot of Stag Rock Mountain adjoining lands of D. Bowen, J. M. Gosnell and others. I William Reid on the 1st part being owner of the said farm above mentioned do hereby bind myself to Lease to the said J. M. Fisher for the term of ten years. The said J. M. Fisher on the 2nd part do hereby

bind myself to lease the said farm for the above stated ten years to pay to the said William Reid twenty dollars per year for the 1st five years falling due on the 1st day of Nov. of each year, the 1st payment falling on the 1st day of November eighteen hundred & eighty eight, one payment falling due each year for the next ensuing four years.
