sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Walter  
W. Holcombe, all that piece or parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville  
in the State of South Carolina, conveyed to me

by W. F. Shumate & P. H. Kelly on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January  
A. D. 1882; said conveyance having been recorded in  
the Office of Register of Meine Conveyance for County  
& State of South Carolina on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1882
