all of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina
and Permelia Redman, James M. Cox and Stephen
A. Cox of Hall County, in the State of Georgia, all of
whom are heirs at Law of James W. Jackson, deceas-
ed, late of the County of Greenville and State of South
Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of
One Hundred and one Dollars to us in hand
paid at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents, by T. E. Wood of the County and State last
ofore said, have granted, bargained, sold, and released
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said T. E. Wood all of that certain piece
parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being
in Sabuda Township in the County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina containing forty
five acres and a half more or less, and bounded
by lands of Mack Robertson, John Rodes, John W.
Johnson and others. It being a portion of a hun-
dred and one acre tract of land willed to James Jackson

we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors
and Administrators to warrant and forever

the said T. E. Wood his heirs and assigns against
us and our heirs and against every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
