Thompson and Martha C. Thompson as Administrators and Administratrix of the estate of John Farrow deceased and Martha C. Thompson individually demand ing judgment in relation to the real estate herein after mentioned and described, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th day of July 1885, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decretal order of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate herein after mentioned and described, be sold by S. consideration of the sum of Two thousand one hundred and sixty Dollars to me paid by the said Mary R. Blakely the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mary R. Blakely, all that tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State of said on branch waters of Kildin's Creek, waters of Enoree River, in the Laurens Road, seven miles South East of Greenville City, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a white oak 3x down on branch thence N. 48 W. 30.60 to a Red Oak 3x on Laurens Road thence S. 40 1/2 W. 58.00 to a stone 3x m. thence N. 70 1/2 E. 55.00 to a Black Jack stake 3x; thence N. 21 E. 9.45 to the beginning corner containing one hundred and eighteen acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of R. E. Cox, Alexander Forester and others.
