Know all Men by these Presents, That I, St. John Cox in the State of one said, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by John Henry Kame, same State and County (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do Grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Henry Kame, all those certain pieces or lots of land situated, lying & being in Ward six (6) of the City of Greenville facing on Plum Street and more particularly described as follows, Beginning at a stake on the North side of Plum St. & the East side of Robinson St. thence along Plum St. fifty feet to a stake, thence parallel to Robinson St. one hundred feet to a stake, thence Westwardly parallel with Plum St. fifty feet to a stake on Robinson St. thence Southly along Robinson St. one hundred feet to the point of beginning, and known as lot Eleven, Block Two. Also, Beginning at a stake on North side of Plum St. and fifty feet Easterly from corner of Plum & Robinson Street, thence along Plum St. fifty feet to a stake, thence Northwardly parallel with Robinson St. one hundred feet to a stake, thence Westwardly parallel with Plum St. fifty feet to a stake, thence Southly parallel with Robinson St. one hundred feet to the point of the beginning and known as Lot Twelve, Block two, of a Division of lands bounded by Sanson, Lewis & Plum Streets & the Columbia & Greenville Rail Road together with all and singular the Rights, menues, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the same and to hold all and singular the said premises, before mentioned unto the said John Henry Kame his heirs and assigns forever.
