 miles from Greenville City, adjoining lands of
 Stephen Griffith, D. W. Taylor and A. Forester, contain-
 ing Twenty Acres, more or less, and being a part
 of the land conveyed to A. Forester by D. W. Griffith,
 which is fully described, and duly recorded, in
 Book 7, page 593, in the office of the Register of Deeds
 Conveyance for Greenville County. Together with
 all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging,
 or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have
 and to hold, all and singular the said premises
 before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Rhoda L. Fos-
 ter, her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
