granted, bargained, sold and released and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said William Elmone, all that certain  
tract or parcel of land, lying and situate in  
the County and State of aforesaid, on the North side  
of Enoree River, and being a part of the Estate  
of Jeremiah Glenn, deid, known as the Wooduff
