This Indenture witnesseth that William Poinsett Dooly of his own free will and accord and by and with the consent and approbation of his mother put himself apprentice unto G. H. Neves, to learn to farm, and after manner of an apprentice to serve the said G. H. Neves from the date hereof for and during and unto the end and term of Fourteen years or until he becomes Twenty one years old, during all which term the said Wm. Poinsett Dooly, shall faithfully serve and all secrets keep and all lawful commands everywhere readily obey and shall do no damage to the said G. H. Neves nor see it done by others, without telling or giving notice thereof to said G. H. Neves shall not waste any goods nor lend them unlawfully to any, nor contract matrimony within the said term, at cards, dice or any unlawful game shall not play whereby said G. H. Neves may have damage with his own goods, nor the goods of others, without license from the said G. H. Neves shall not neither buy nor sell and shall not absent himself from said service day or night without leave, nor haunt ale-houses, Taverns or play houses, but in all things behave himself as a faithful apprentice ought to do during the said term. And the said G. H. Neves shall use the utmost of his endeavors to teach or cause to be taught or instructed the said apprentice in the art or trade of a farmer, and procure and provide for him sufficient meat, drink, lodging and washing fitting for an apprentice to learn of Fourteen years or until he becomes 21 years old and for the time
