Also to conduct and carry on the business of Merchandising, to buy and sell all goods and Merchandising appertaining to said business as he may deem proper and to make and sign for me and in my name all bills or bonds or notes which shall be necessary to the proper conducting of said business. And generally to do all such acts and things appertaining to my said property or any part of same, or to my business in any way as to him shall seem best for my interest, giving my said attorney full power to do every thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises and business as fully as I could do if personally
