hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold  
and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said Moses H. Fowler  
a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being  
in the State and County of said being a portion  
of the tract of land belonging to Alvin Wilson decd. of the  
State and County of said, joining lands of John  
H. Wilson, J. H. Abernethy Junr, and others contain-  
ing Forty five Acres, more or less, For further partic-  
ulars, courses and distances see survey and plat  
made by H. P. Johnson Aug. the Eleventh 1884.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members,  
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining  
To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said prem-
