 ville County on a Branch of the Golden Goose Creek  
 containing Sixty Acres, more or less, Beginning  
 on a Red Oak corner, thence North to the creek, thence  
 down the meanders of the creek until it intersects the  
 other line, thence East to the beginning, it being a part  
 of a tract of land of six hundred and forty acres  
 granted unto the said Joseph Benson by his Excellency  
 Benjamin Guerry, Esquire, Governor and Commander  
 in Chief in and over the said State at Charleston, dated  
 the sixteenth day of July, Anno Domini one thousand  
 seven hundred and eighty four and in the ninth  
 year of the Independence of the United States of America
