Six thousand (\$6,000) Dollars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing  
of these Presents, by the United States of America  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO  
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said United States of America all that certain  
piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the City and County  
of Greenville in the State aforesaid and having the following bearings and bounds  
to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the end of the west side of main Street  
two feet from the N. E. West corner of main and Broad Streets and running thence with  
main Street towards the Public Square Seventy Eight feet to an iron pin in  
the line of the west side of main Street one thousand and fifty feet from  
Broad Street thence from the two points above indicated on two lines  
running with right angles with main Street parallel with Broad  
Street and with each other one hundred and ten feet thence  
shalls back line which runs parallel with main Street and  
is Seventy Eight feet in length as will appear by Great Survey  
Copy and in drossed.
