Inow a lot in the town

of Fountain Inn beginning at N.E. corner of Townville Street and Ediston Street and running thence N 82 E 4.70 to stake thence N 38 E 26. to stake thence S 52 E 4.70 to stake thence S 38 E 4.26 to beginning corner binding on Ediston at the Townville Street and lands belonging to said Cannon, eldest the lot being the same that was deeded by Cannon and went to John H. Bellams and subsequently by J. R. Bellams to B. C. Thomason and Alice Thomason on 2^d day of November 1888 and containing two acres more or less

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
