TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said James Gosnell His Heirs and Assigns forever. AND we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said James Gosnell His Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
