Browning*, all that certain lot of land situate lying and being between Washington and John Streets and on Butler Avenue in the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid. Containing nine-tenths ($\frac{9}{10}$) of an acre more or less and having the following metes, bounds and lines to wit: Beginning at the corner of Washington Street and Butler Avenue and running thence with Butler Avenue $\frac{1}{2}$ two hundred and eighty-three (283) feet to John Street, thence with John Street $\frac{1}{2}$ one hundred and thirty-nine (139) feet to Main Street corner, thence with Main Street $\frac{1}{2}$ two hundred and eighty and a half (280 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet to Washington Street, thence with Washington Street $\frac{1}{2}$ one hundred and forty (140) feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot annexed to me by *J.
