Know all men by these presents that I, Mary N. Stokes of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the love and affection I have and bear to my daughter Henrietta E. Gaines and for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me paid by my said daughter have given and conveyed and by these presents do give and convey to the said Henrietta E. Gaines during her life time (on the conditions herein after set forth) all that tract and parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on Belders Creek waters of Enore River the same being all my land on the right hand side of the Public Road leading from the present residence of Jesse C. Kilgore to Anderson Bridge on Enore River allotted to me in the division of the Homestead tract of land of my father Josiah Kilgore as will appear by a Deed made by James N. Dickson dated 17th of May 1879. (the land allotted to me in said deed situate on the left hand side of said Road leading to Anderson Bridge on Enore River from Jesse C. Kilgore's residence does not conveyed by this deed but I reserve

I suppose about one hundred and seventy five acres more or less and is bounded on the North by the aforesaid Public Road leading from Jesse C. Kilgore's present residence to Anderson Bridge on the East by lands that were allotted to my sister Harriet J. Hunter on the South by lands allotted to my Brother P. F. Kilgore now owned by Mr. White and on the West by lands of said Jesse C. Kilgore the Southern Eastern and Western boundaries of said tract of land are designated in the said Deed made by James N. Dickson attached to the deed of J. J. Southern made to me except that five or six acres of said land was recovered in a suit by P. F. Kilgore Trustee against me on the western side of said tract. The said tract and parcel of land I hereby convey to my said daughter Henrietta E. Gaines on these expressed conditions and on no other that is to say said tract of land is to be held kept used and employed by her for the sole separate and exclusive use benefit advantage and support of my said daughter Henrietta E. Gaines and her family (free from any charge or liability for her debts and contracts or those of her family) during her natural life and at her death the said tract of land shall be equally divided among her children whom may survive her and the children of any child or children of my said daughter that may die before my said daughter living at her death such grand children of my daughter taking among them the share of their deceased parent. The said tract of land shall not be sold or conveyed away during the life time of my said daughter but remain in her possession until her death and then be divided among her children and issue if any as aforesaid as remain down.
