M^r. Daniel Clerk as aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said Trustees; Now therefore know all men by these presents, That we, Thomas C. Gower and Whitner Symmes, Trustees as aforesaid, by virtue of the powers conferred upon us in and by the order and Trust Deed aforesaid upon the the written request of the certain question and in performance of our duty as such Trustees and also in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty two Dollars to us paid by Whitner Symmes for the delivery of these presents, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Whitner Symmes all those pieces parcels or lots of land - being parcels of land above mentioned - situate and lying in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, commencing at a stake, corner Lot No. twelve on West Street running thence N 34 1/4 E fifty feet to stake thence S 55 1/2 W one hundred and fifty six feet to stake thence S 4 1/2 E fifteen feet to stake on Lot No. ten thence N 85 1/2 E eighty one feet and five inches to stake on Lot No. ten thence N 55 1/2 E one hundred and eighty eight feet and three inches to the beginning and known in the Deeds survey as Lot No. eleven also that other parcel or Lot of land in the same City and State commencing at a stake on forty feet street running thence S 1/2 E one hundred feet to stake on Lot No. six and thence N 55 1/2 E one hundred and fifty feet to stake on Lot No. eleven
