to a stake or pin, thence S 20 W One hundred and twenty
and one third feet to a stake or pin on North street
and thence with North street One hundred and twenty six

and North streets and lots of Mrs. Susan C. Balling sit-
ting the same lot and thence conveyed by Susan C.
Balling to Mary E. Easton and Alivia V. Clark by deed
