High Towers - 38, thence N 19 W 45, 41 thence to a pine 34, thence N 37 E 25-00 Lines to a stone 34, thence N 33 E to Big Tree Creek, thence down said Creek to the mouth where it continues into North Fork of Saluda River, thence west J. E. Turners, line to a stone 34, said Turners 34, thence to the beginning, containing two Hundred and fifty acres, less than some more or less, it being the law on or south west end of a tract of Land conveyed to me by John F. High Towers, known as the Mc Wining tract, bounded by Lands of W.O. High Towers J. E. Turners, and others, together with all and singular the rights, incidents, tenements and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Seyphemia High Towers, her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend - and to give up the said premises unto the said Seyphemia High Towers her heirs - and all other persons lawfully claiming or offering to claim the same on any point thereby, Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of August, in the 10th year of - Lord, 1849. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Geo Westmoreland & P. M. B. Freeman their heirs and assigns forever, And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George Westmoreland & P. M. B. Freeman their heirs and assigns against us and our heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any point thereof.
