This agreement made this day between Paschal Huff Charles A. Perkins John H Latimer and James H Latimer on the one part and Hewlett Sullivan on the second part Witnesseth that the said parties on the first part viz Paschal D Huff Charles A Perkins John H Latimer and James H Latimer have this day sold to Hewlett Sullivan all their interest in the Fork Shoal Factory lands hereditaments and appurtenances there to on the following conditions that he the said Hewlett Sullivan is to receive them of the payment of the balance of the purchase money due the assignee viz \$6000 with interest thereon from the 1st day of July 1882 in other words settle and pay off the mortgage the said assignee holds on them but what it may in amount and when the said parties above mentioned also agree and promise to turn over to the said Hewlett Sullivan all insurance policies they now hold on Factory property prosecute the claim for discount by he the said Hewlett Sullivan paying all expenses of so prosecuting the suit for a discount by reason of the property not being what it was represented when sold by Assignee & Co.

And the said Hewlett Sullivan on the second part agrees to take the said property upon the terms already expressed and explained to assume the payment of all the balance of the purchase money on mortgage due said assignee. Witness my hand and seal this 24th day of July 1883.
