

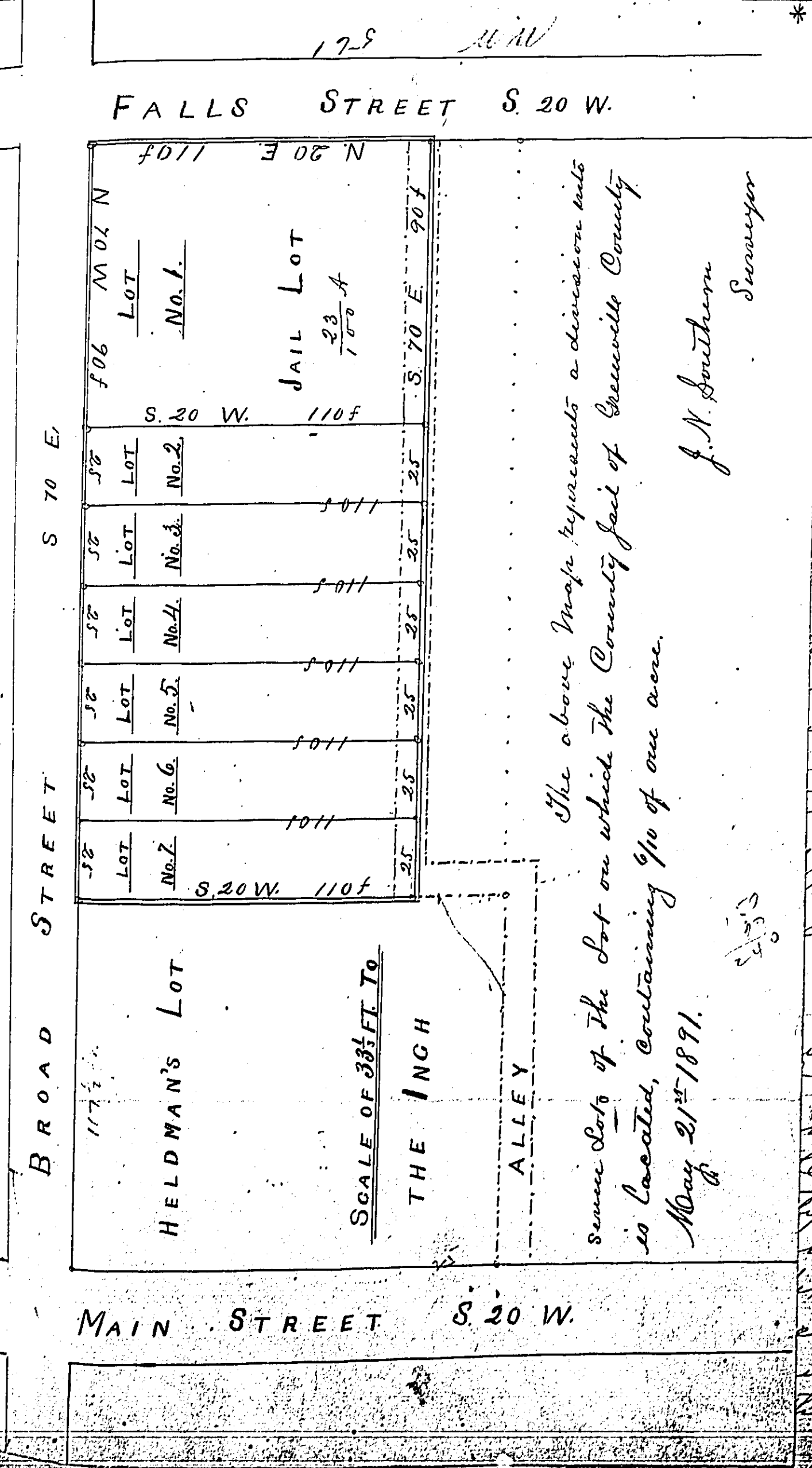

 To wit: to Real Estate Whereas the County Comm-
 issioners in and for Greenville
 County in the State aforesaid by an Act of the Legisla-
 ture of said state approved the 20th day of December
 A. D. 1890 are authorized empowered and required
 to sell and convey in fee simple a portion of the
 Jail lot in Greenville City for purposes therein men-
 tioned; and whereas the said County Commission-
 ers for the better disposition of said property have
 had one hundred and fifty (150) feet of said lot
 situated on the South side of Broad Street to the East
 of the property of George Heldman and lying be-
 tween said property and that portion of the Jail
 lot on which the new Jail now stands surveyed
 and cut up into six lots of twenty five (25) feet
 front each and numbered from two (2) to seven (7)
 inclusive on a plat made by J. N. Southern D. S.
 on the 21st day of May A. D. 1891 and recorded as
 hereinafter stated; and whereas said lots after
 due notice were exposed to sale at Public Out-
 cry in front of the Court House door on sales
 day on June A. D. 1891 and Thomas D. Donaldson
 became the purchaser of lots numbered two (2) and
 three (3) on said plat at the sum of three hundred
 (300⁰⁰) dollars and three hundred and thirty (330⁰⁰)
 dollars respectively being at said prices the highest
 bidder therefor.
