 of the Legislature, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened,  
 released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell  
 and release in to the said Thomas D. Donaldson  
 full that certain piece or lot of land situated lying and  
 being in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid  
 beginning on the South side of Broad Street at an  
 Iron pin in the North East Corner of lot No 4 on plot herein  
 referred to and running thence with the line of said lot  
 East 110 feet to an Iron Pin thence S 70<sup>00</sup> E 50 feet to an Iron  
 Pin thence N 20<sup>00</sup> E 110 feet to Broad Street thence with said  
 Broad Street N 70<sup>00</sup> W 30 feet to the beginning corner and  
 being a part of the original Jail Lot and known as
