Trammell being the owner of the premises bounded by any mortgage judgement or other lien of a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina containing one acre lying on branch waters of Muskhog Creek bounded as follows Beginning on an Apple tree near South East corner of the Distillery

Beginning therefrom due North 70 yards to a Rock thence due West 70 yards to a Rock thence due South 70 yards to a Rock thence due East 70 yards to the beginning corner Bounded on all sides by lands of Stonewall J. Trammell Do hereby consent that the said premises may be used by John H. Trammell for the purpose of distilling spirits subject to the provisions of this law This consent to exist for the period of five years and I do hereby stipulate and agree that the lien of the United States for taxes and penalties shall have priority of all my right title and interest in said tract of land or any claim in my behalf and that in the case of forfeiture of said premises or any part thereof the title of the same shall rest in the United States discharged from all my right title interest or any claim in my behalf.
