C. Markley as their Sales Agent under the limitations and restrictions herein after specified for the sale of Wagons Spring wagons and Carriages of their manufacture to be shipped the party of the second part as per order here with or here after to be made or for goods now on hand or in transit unsold belonging to said Company in the following described territory to wit, Greenville S. C. and said Agent agrees as follows first to do all business pertaining to selling the above named goods shipped under this agreement to pay all freights and to keep them well housed and protected from the weather and in good order during the life of this contract or until sold paid for or reshipped free of taxes storage losses and other expenses thereon and to be governed by the printed instructions on the back of this contract and the instructions of the Studebaker Bros Mfg Co. Second In no case to charge the said Company with any sum or sums of freight handling or reshipping storage or other expenses except by special agreement in writing with said Company or their authorized Sales Agents third To insure for the benefit of said Company all goods shipped
