 Joseph A McCullough Recorded in Book 127 Page 681
 Reference to which deed is hereby had. Together with
 all action or cause of action I may have in regard to or con
 cerning said land however said action or cause of action
 may have become accrued in me up to the date and

 and H V Westmoreland Executors of the estate of George Cunningham
 late of Greenville County in the State aforesaid deceased, send greeting.
 Whereas the said George Cunningham departed this life leaving
 of force his Last Will and Testament under the provisions of which
 his Executors are empowered to sell certain of his lands and make

 sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Emma A Westmoreland
 full that piece parcel and tract of land containing thirty
 nine and three fourths acres more or less situate
 lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
 west of and near Green on waters of South Tyger River
 and has the following metes and bounds to wits. Beginning
 at a stone 34 m on a branch. Thence S 1 1/2 W 9.90 to a stone 34 m
 Thence S 88 3/4 E 17.50 to a stone 34 m Thence N 1/2 E 26.88 to a stone 31.0 once a history
 Thence S 65 1/4 W 12.70 to a sower wood 31.0 near a branch dead. Thence
