This deed made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of Dec 1891 by Mrs L C Forrest of Spartanburg County and State of South Carolina of the 1<sup>st</sup> part to William Roberson of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the second part with intent that said L C Forrest in consideration of Two hundred dollars to her paid by Wm Roberson the part of which is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold her interest and by these presents does bargain sell convey to said Wm Roberson and his Heirs assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in Greenville County State of South Carolina adjoining the lands of William Turner and others bounded as follows viz Beginning on a white oak on the North side of Jarrison Creek and runs west 23 E 62 35 to a pine thence N 12 West 7 5 to a stake originally an oak thence N 62 West 71 30 to a stake in Turners line thence with Turners line S 34 West 29 to a black oak Turners corner thence with Turners line South 56 West 23 50 to a white oak Turners corner thence to the beginning containing
